	applications to the educational and professional environments, capable of dealing
	effectively with issues of diversity, providing guidance on teaching and learning
	processes, and understanding the difficulties inherent in these processes;
	-provide students with an in-depth understanding of how to plan and manage
	educational psychology services, orientation, consultancy and evaluation;
	-train students to carry out effective critical analyses and interpretations of educational
	psychology policies, practises and treatment scenarios, which will provide the basis for
	competent professional practice and the improvement of teaching and learning
	processes;
	-introduce students to a range of tools and strategies for improving the planning and
	management of educational psychology services, guidance, consultancy and evaluation;
	-illustrate how to respond ethically and professionally to various theoretical and
	practical issues that may arise in future professional practice.

	-plan, organize and implement services in the field of educational psychology;
	-apply basic management principals to coordinated activity planning and leadership of
	educational psychology teams, supporting collaborative work between different agents
	and institutions;
	-analyse, interpret and propose strategies, taking into account educational policies in a
	dynamic and constantly evolving social context;
	-formulate new strategies for improving educational psychology practices, based on the
	results of research in this field.

	disciplinary contexts; -take decisions based on problem analysis, through the critical application of the latest

	knowledge and reasons that justify them, to specialized and non-specialized audiences;
	-show an awareness of beliefs and stereotypes in their own, and other, cultures and of the effects these can have on professional practice;
