The **Erasmus Mundus STETTIN** Project is a partnership consisting of European Institutions and the ACP countries (African, Caribbean and Pacific). It aims to develop and build an interinstitutional cooperation for teacher training in scientific, technical and professional education fields. This project is financed by the European Commission through the Erasmus Mundus Action 2 program, and is one of the programs of cooperation between the European Union and Third Countries.

The specific objectives of the program are:

- To contribute to the mutual enrichment of societies by developing the qualifications of men and women, in order for them to acquire international experience and the adapted skills relevant to the labour market.
- Promoting the mobility of students, researchers, teachers and administrative staff from third countries - particularly those from vulnerable groups - and the selection is based on their academic excellence, in order that they can obtain the qualifications and/or experience in Europe;
- Contribute to the development of human resources and the international cooperation capacity of higher education institutions in third countries through the important mobility flow between Europe and third countries, based on the equal opportunities and non-discrimination principles.

Who may apply? | 2

Nationals of ACP countries may apply in order to achieve their master studies or the mobility periods, such as doctoral students or administration or academic staff in European partner institutions.

In order to be eligible for the mobility, applicants must fulfill and meet the following criteria:

- Have the nationality of one of the ACP countries
- May not have the status of « resident » or having exercised their main activity (studies, work, etc...) for more than 12 months during the last 5 years in one of the eligible European countries.
- Have not benefited from an Erasmus Mundus scholarship for the same type of mobility in the past.

The different target groups that may apply:

Target Group I	Be enrolled in a ACP area partner institution of the STETTIN project Master, Doctorate, Academic or administrative staff
Target Group II	May enrolled or having completed a university degree in an institution of an ACP country Master
Target Group III	Be from ACP area, in particularly vulnerable situation due to social, political or economic reasons. Master

- Passport with a minimum validity date: September 2016
- Photocopies of last obtained diploma and a transcript (an official document from the applicant's institution).
- A letter of recommendation from the Higher Education of the candidate required for the mobility of PhD students or academic or administrative staff.
- The applicants of the Target Group 3 must submit an official document showing proof of their eligibility in this group.
